### AGM Report

I'll keep this as brief as I can.

- The new rules were adopted at the meeting and are now in force.
- We now have two JB's on the Management Committee (as if one wasn't enough). Graeme Pitt will lead the team responsible for the ground, pavilion and facilities and Andy Hitchcock becomes cricket supremo to support returning 1<sup>st</sup> XI skipper Adam Morton and the continuing 2<sup>nd</sup> and Sunday XI duo, Matt Fields and Andy Sheldon.
- Those who attended the meeting were convinced that the Club needs to really get involved with CricketForce (see above). If you join in and play your part we could make a lot happen in the Club.
- Concern was expressed at the League's insistence on imposing panel umpiring for Division 4 matches. The effect of this would be to prevent our long-standing umpire Derrick Wallace from officiating in League games.
