CricketForce 2010 – 26, 27 & 28 March

Some of you will know something about CricketForce. It's a self help cricket club event which offers a variety of benefits to build a legacy within cricket. CricketForce is the nation's largest volunteer event. It provides an opportunity to engage with the local community to attract new volunteers, to rejuvenate and improve facilities (pavilions and grounds) and encourage people to play a more active role in their club, all for the benefit and long term future of grassroots cricket
At the start of the cricket season there's always a stack of things to do and at the CricketForce weekend we have a long list. In rough order of priority they are:

Task	Workers needed	Details
1. Strip and re-clad water tower	4	The existing cladding has lasted about 45 years and is clapped out! We'll have the materials
2. Set up covers and mobile nets	2-3	We've had work done on the cover frames making it easier to attach the sheeting. The netting has been eaten away at the bottom and needs to be replaced – either completely or with a new lower section - so we can use the cage for juniors this year.
3. Cut outfield / work on square	2	Specialist work – SG and JW will do this!
4. Gents toilets - ceiling repairs / repair paving slabs outside changing rooms	2	We need to patch up a small area with plasterboard and make good following water leak. Use existing slabs after removing old mortar
5. Pavilion cleaning: wash down walls in main club room & spruce up carpet in main club room (SG will bring a carpet cleaner)	2-3	Self-explanatory - report to Fran Hall
6. Erect new advertising boards / clean existing boards & sightscreens	2-3	We've acquired a number of new supporters over the winter and need to put up their boards. Use power washer to clean off sightscreens and some of the older boards
7. Confirm and mark out scoreboard site / repair scoreboard & numbers / put up shelving etc in colts' equipment cupboard	2-3	We hope to put up a new scoreboard to free space in the pavilion to extend the changing facilities. If possible we want to mark out the site as well as doing other necessary work.
8. Trim hedges and surrounds	2	The hedge alongside the neighbouring property needs to be cut back
9. Catering support	2	We hope to have pasties, tea and coffee to sustain the volunteers. If you like the heat ... come into the kitchen
